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The paradise lagoon famous for the 1980's movie – The Blue Lagoon, is a beautiful unspoiled oasis near the town of San Antonio, Jamaica.

The emerald green waters of the lagoon are being fed by the mineral springs from the Blue Mountains, giving an astonishing feeling of a tropical paradise surrounded by lush and steep hills. While swimming, you can feel the variations of cold and warm streams of water surprising your body. Even if there are parts where the water is so shallow that you can walk around in it, some parts are more than 50m (180 ft) deep.
